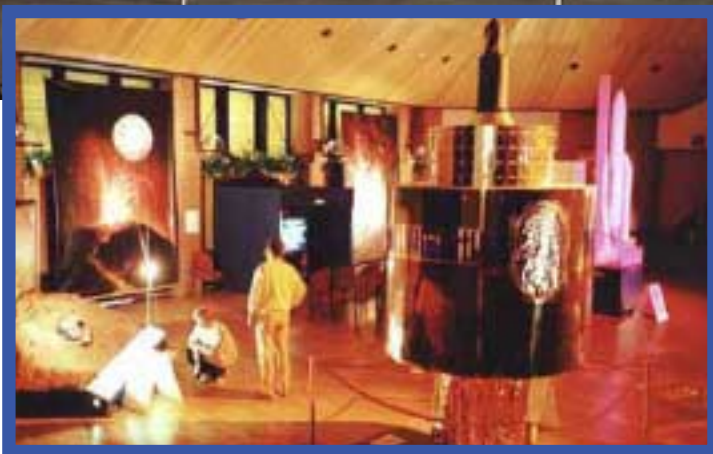

**Rockets, flight simulation!**

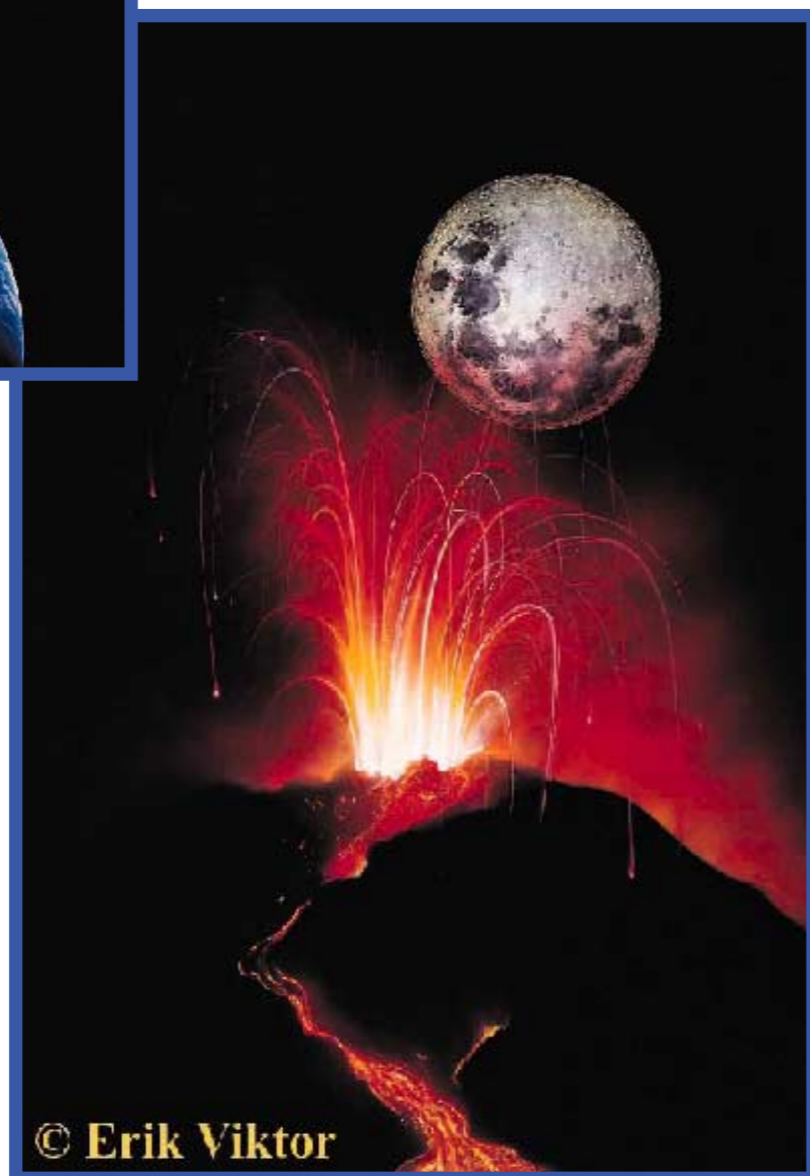


The Spaceshuttle «Phoenix in all its glory». This fiberglass and aluminium model measures 12 metres, with a wingspan of 6.

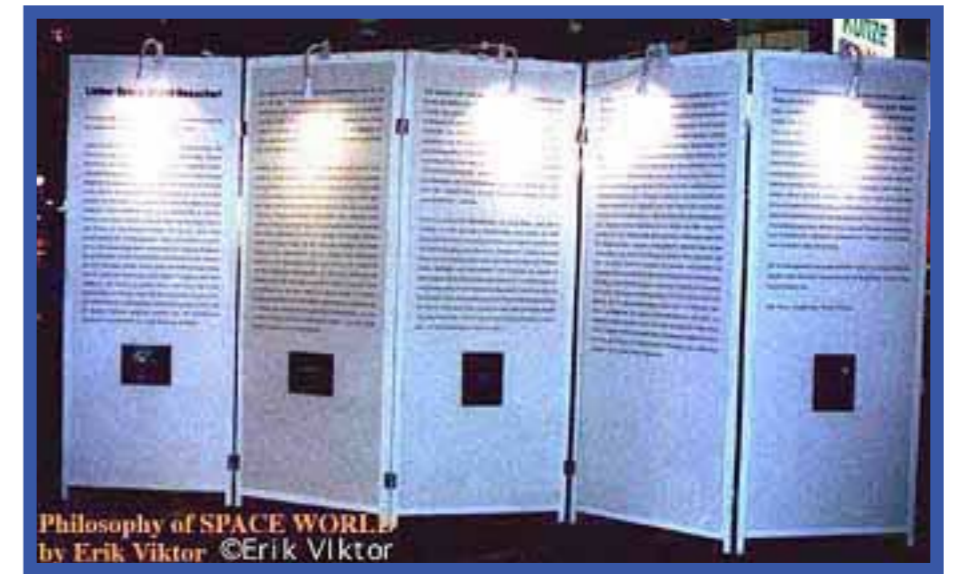


The grand Mars landscape above covers around 30 square metres and is stunningly realistic with its rocks, spacesuit and 9 metre long panoramic painting.

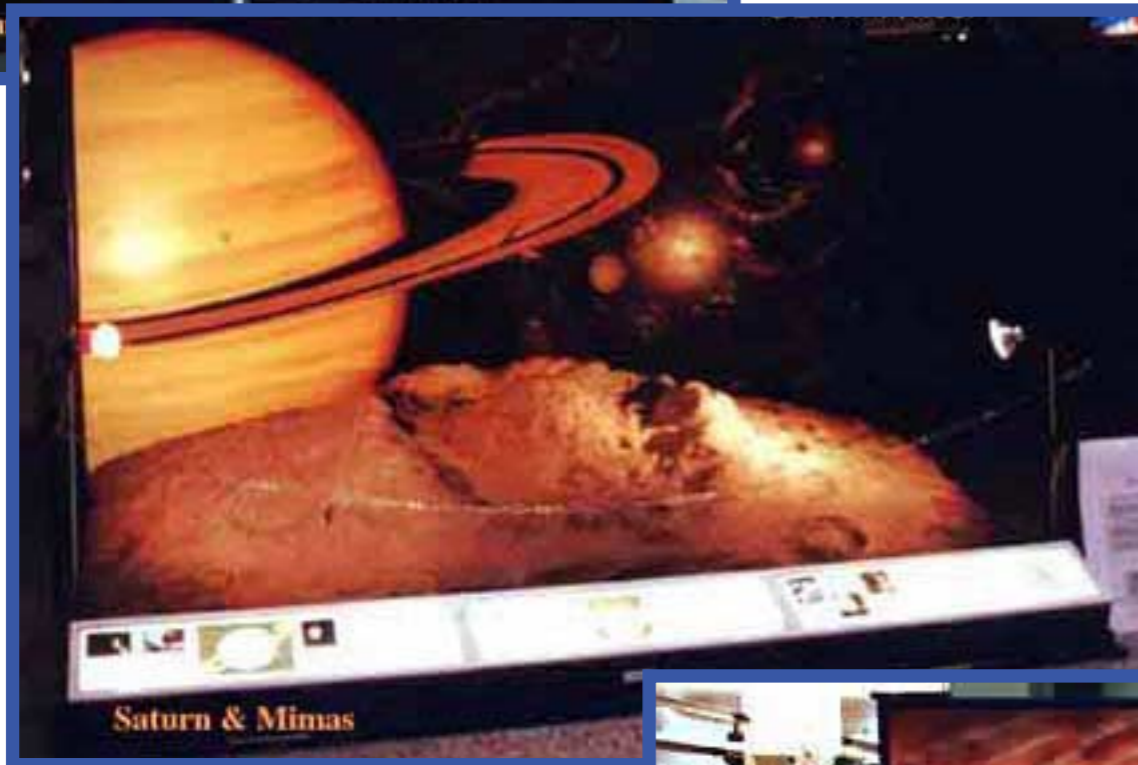

The «Rosetta» or cometary landscape is one of the newer exhibits featuring one of the European Space Agency's newest and more daring missions.



The Saturn or Mimas landscape is similar in design as the moon landscape above. It features Saturn's moon Mimas and a panoramic painting of the gaseous planet.

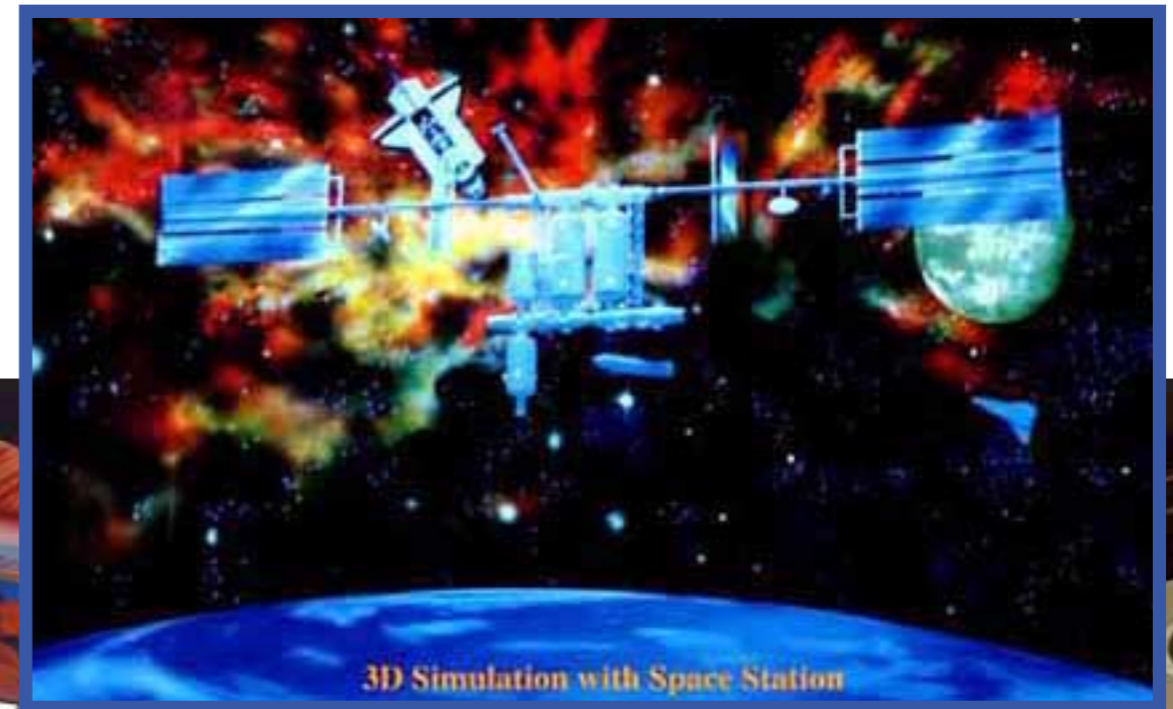
